



New Constitution Offered in Congo

LEOPOLDVILLE, Congo — International efforts for peaceful unification of the Congo appeared to hinge Monday on Katanga President Moïse Tshombe's reaction to proposals for a new constitution, unveiled Sunday by federal Premier Cyrille Adoula.

The constitution would grant local autonomy to the provinces, a concession to Tshombe's demand for a looser central government.

There was no immediate reaction from Elizabethville, the Katanga capital, to Adoula's proposals.

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that can be checked by individuals in the annual campaign to wipe out mosquitoes. Lane County Sanitarian John Stoner pointed out that it takes only about five days for mosquitoes to hatch in hot weather.

Stoner recommends that people locate any possible places where skeeters might hatch. The best method to insure they won't, Stoner advised, is to spread a little oil on the waters.

In the case of neglected ditches or ponds, call the Lane County Health Department and they will send spray crews around, Stoner said.
