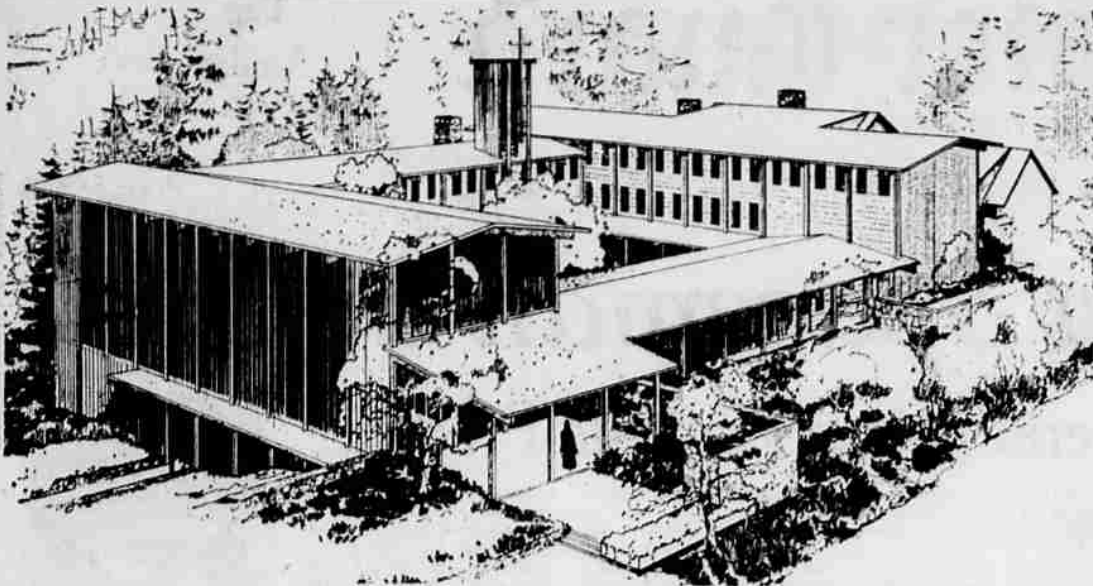




New Wing

Construction is underway now on a \$150,000 L-shaped wing to the monastery of the Carmelite Sisters, Carmel of Maria Regina, on Green Hill Drive, west of Eugene. The new wing, to the left and front in the architects' sketch, will raise the residential capacity of the monastery from the present 13 nuns to 24 or 25, according to the Mother Prioress. The addition

will also provide additional work room for the nuns. At left front is the monastery's new chapel, which features a wall of colored glass on the north. When the new wing is completed in November, a square cloister will be formed in the center. Architects Bogen, Hoseny and Greene of Eugene designed the addition, and construction work is being done by Arnt Ree and Son, contractors.

Two New Ministers

Emerald Empire Churches Fill Vacancies

Staff changes and additions at several Emerald Empire churches will bring some new members of the clergy to the area.

Pulpit posts filled include those of the Eugene Unitarian Church and Trent Church of Christ. In addition, religious education directors have been hired by Central Presbyterian Church and First Christian Church, Eugene.

Posts still to be filled include the senior pastorate at First Methodist Church of Eugene, the pastorate at Eugene Seventh-day Adventists Church and minister to youth at First Baptist Church, Eugene.

New Building, Minister

Members of the Eugene Unitarian Church will be getting a new church building and a new minister early this fall, after lacking both for more than a year.

The new minister is the Rev. Carl J. Nelson, now of Wellesley, Mass. There, the Rev. Nelson is minister of the Church of the Community Universalist Church, which he has served since 1955. He is a graduate of the University of Minnesota, and has also studied at the University of Chicago and Chicago Theological Seminary.

Moves From Jefferson

The Rev. Floyd W. Mackler, pastor of the Jefferson Christian Church, will be the new minister at the Trent Church of Christ. He will assume his duties Sept. 1.

The Rev. Mackler attended Boise Bible College, Boise, Idaho, for one year and then transferred to Minnesota Bible College from which he graduated in 1953 with a bachelor of arts degree. Since then, the Rev. Mackler has done graduate work at the University of Oregon and in 1960 received a bachelor of arts degree in philosophy from Willamette University, Salem.

The Rev. and Mrs. Mackler have been at the Jefferson Christian Church 4½ years. Mrs. Mackler is a graduate of Boise Bible College. They have two children, Arlene Kay, 9, and Douglas William, 6.

The Rev. Dick Reeve, who has been pastor at Trent for five years, resigned recently to resume his studies. Since his departure, the Rev. Dick Smith of Eugene has been serving as interim pastor at Trent.

Seminary Graduate

A young woman with theological seminary training, Judy Gunkler, arrived in Eugene last

week to begin work as director of religious education for Central Presbyterian Church.

Miss Gunkler, a native of Rochester, N. Y., is a commissioned church worker. This, she explained, is a Presbyterian classification which requires training at a Presbyterian seminary.

After graduation from the College of Wooster, Wooster, Ohio with a bachelor of arts degree in religion, Miss Gunkler entered San Francisco Theological Seminary, San Anselmo, Calif. She graduated from seminary in June with a master of arts degree in Christian education.

At Central, Miss Gunkler will be working in teacher training, the church school and youth and adult education programs. She has spent several summers working in playground recreation jobs. Her hobby is sailing.

Third in Family

First Christian Church, Eugene, announced last week that Malcolm McCallum, the son and grandson of former pastors of First Christian, has become the

church's new minister of Christian education.

He graduated in June, 1947, from the University of Oregon. He attended Northwest Christian College, and in June, 1953, received a bachelor of divinity degree from Christian Theological Seminary. He has also studied at the University of California at Berkeley and the Pacific School of Religion, also at Berkeley.

In addition to several pastorate and associate minister positions, he served for two years as a fraternal worker in

Egypt for the Near East Christian Council Committee for Refugee Work.

McCallum will be the third in his family to serve at First Christian. His grandfather, James S. McCallum, was minister of the Eugene church from 1902 to 1914. During his pastorate, the present building at 1172 Oak Street was built.

Malcolm's father, Hugh Neal McCallum, was pastor of the Eugene church from 1945 to 1949.
