

## Speaker Led Church's Aid For Refugees

Kathleen L. Belknap, acting director of the Evangelical Refugee Center in Miami, Fla., will be guest speaker Sunday at First Assembly of God, 1330 Madison St., Eugene.

She will speak at 7 p.m. standard, 8 p.m. daylight. The program will be open to the public.

Miss Belknap, a missionary in Cuba for eight years previous to 1960, founded the refugee center with another missionary in December, 1960. Since then, the center has provided spiritual and material aid to some 6,000 Cuban refugees.

The refugees, which now number some 100,000, arrive in Florida with only a few possessions, some with only the clothing they are wearing, Miss Belknap said.

Upon arrival in the United States, she said, the refugees are interviewed and cleared by the U.S. Immigration Service and the U.S. Government Emergency Center. At the latter, they are given money "for their most urgent needs" and housing, which is now getting scarce in the area—usually requires most of this check, she said.

The church centers, such as the one that Miss Belknap operates, then enter the picture. They provide the refugees with used clothing and groceries, until the families qualify for surplus foods. Church agencies, she said, also provide monthly groceries in some cases to "round out" the government's food grants.

## New Church Put Into Use
