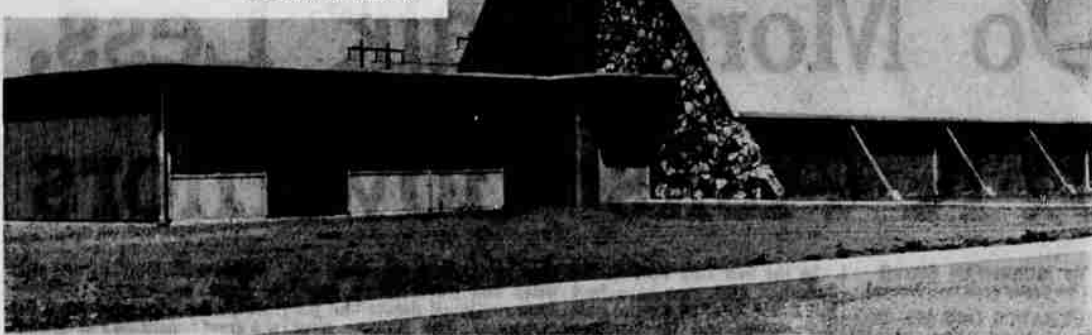


Asbury's First Unit

UO Students To Attend Conference

A number of Eugeneans and students at the University of Oregon will be in Beloit, Wis., late this month to attend the National Study Conference of the United Campus Christian Fellowship.

The meeting, scheduled Aug. 25-30, is the first such conference since the UCCF was organized in 1960 in Columbia, Mo. Delegates to the conference will be discussing and studying the relationship of Christian vocation to such issues as world revolution, culture, education and religion.

Don David of Eugene, a student at the University of Oregon and regional UCCF president, will be among the delegates. Others will be Nancy Edling of Monmouth, a university student and regional editor of the UCCF, and four other University students, Vicki Feder of North Bend, Pat Lowry of Hermiston, Wayne Johnston of Portland and Jay West of Glendale, Calif., president of the UO Westminster Fellowship.

The Rev. G. Gordon Goldthwaite, pastor to Presbyterian students at the University of Oregon, and the Rev. Lloyd Stamp, First Congregational Church of Eugene, pastor to Congregational students, also plan to attend the conference and the separate meetings for university pastors of the four participating denominations that will follow.

Churches that joined forces in 1960 to form the campus organization are the Christian Churches (Disciples of Christ), Evangelical United Brethren, United Presbyterian Church in the U.S.A., and the United Church of Christ. The latter denomination is a union of the Congregational Christian Churches and the Evangelical and Reformed Church.

Church to Hold Services at Camp

Immanuel Lutheran Brethren Church, 1492 W. Second Ave., Eugene, has canceled its regular services at the church Sunday and will hold a program at Camp Lutherwood.

Sunday school members and the congregation will meet at the church Sunday at 9:30 a.m. standard, 10:30 daylight, to go to Camp Lutherwood, 22 miles from Eugene on Highway 36, west of Alderwood State Park. Sport clothes will be in order. At the camp, a combination Sunday school and church program is planned, followed by a potluck picnic and recreational activities. Church Schedules Guest Speaker

The Rev. John G. Olson, director of public relations and radio for Air Mail from God Mission, will be guest speaker Sunday at the Church of the Open Bible, 3195 Hilyard St., Eugene.

He will speak at 7 p.m. standard, 8 daylight, and the service is open to the public.

The Rev. and Mrs. Olson are radio missionaries of the mission program, and the missionary has recently returned from a trip to Mexico.

Asbury Methodist Plans Consecration of New Unit

Consecration ceremonies for the new \$83,000 unit of Asbury Methodist Church — located at 1090 Berntzen Rd. in Eugene's Bethel-Danebo area — will be held Sunday.

Bishop A. Raymond Grant, Portland, will be in Eugene for the ceremonies, which are scheduled at 11 a.m. standard, noon daylight, at the church's regular worship service.

Bishop Grant will be guest speaker for the service. Other participants in the service will include the Rev. E. J. Aschenbrenner of Eugene, Methodist District superintendent, the Rev. John Ginter, the pastor, and Robert Fish, secretary

of Asbury's board of trustees. Fish will officially present the church structure to the bishop for consecration.

Drive Successful

Asbury Methodist was organized on Palm Sunday, 1961, and first services were held — at a school — on May 7, 1961. After a successful fund-raising drive, building on the 4.29-acre site began.

Contractor for the Chapel and classroom unit was A and G Construction Co. of Springfield. Architect for the unit and for the church's "Master site plan" was James Keefe of Eugene. Tom Conway of the congrega-

tion served as building committee chairman.

Other members of the building committee are Al Lathan, Anne Haase, Robert Fish, Robert Simmons, Roy Borresen, Thomas Hornig and John Herbert.

Simmons is chairman of the church's official board, and Lewis Madsen is president of the board of trustees. Fish is secretary of the trustees, and Harry Christner is vice president. Other trustees are Donald Land, Harold Jole, Robert Fullerton and Charles Tinker.

The new unit contains a chapel seating 150 persons, six classrooms and a pastor's study and church office.

All are of contemporary design.

The chapel, which appears to be an A-frame design from the outside, has a "gothic" appearance in the interior, the Rev. Ginter said. There are colored glass windows near the peak, under the eaves and in a long vertical window strip on the side facing the street.

The strip of windows reflects various colors on the chapel's altar screen, which is formed of sealed cedar with diamond-shaped openings.

Future plans call for the construction of a sanctuary to seat 450 persons, a fellowship hall to seat 500 persons at tables and 12 additional classrooms.

270 Members

At present, the Rev. Ginter said, the young congregation has 270 members, with an additional 30 persons expected to join in the near future.

"We anticipate," the Rev. Ginter said, "that in September we will have two morning worship services."

Sunday's consecration service will feature the church's choir, under the direction of Albert Lund. Marge Welman will be organist for the service.

An open house at the church, which is open to the public, will be held Sunday from 3 to 5 p.m. standard, 4 to 6 daylight. Refreshments will be served.

Evangelist On Mission To Far East

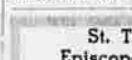
A former Emerald Empire resident, who is now an evangelist with headquarters in Portland has left for a tour of Japan and the Philippines.

He is the Rev. Tom C. Fair, who attended Coburg schools and at one time was general superintendent of the W. C. Crone Lumber Co. in Veneta. He also lived in Eugene at one time.

Fair left July 24 for a program of Bible conferences and crusades. In the Philippines, he will conduct nightly meetings at the Baptist church, daily meetings at the Bible Institute in Manila and the Inter-Varsity group at the University of the Philippines.

He will speak at a large evangelistic rally sponsored by the Greater Manila Fellowship. Much of his preaching in Japan will be done through an interpreter.
