

Student Hails Exchange Plan

Exchange programs — especially those that bring residents of foreign countries to live with families — "will do much for the understanding of people," according to Yvon (pronounced E-von) Disengomoka, a high school student from the Congo. Disengomoka will begin his second year in America this fall.

Yvon, now 17, came to the United States last fall under a student program sponsored by the International Christian Youth Exchange Program. In Eugene he is being sponsored by United Lutheran Church, although in his home city, Leopoldville, Yvon is a member of a Baptist church.

For his first year, Yvon lived with a United Lutheran family. Mr. and Mrs. Erwin Juif, 2565 Van Ness St., Eugene.

He will soon move to the home of Mr. and Mrs. John M. Gustafson, 1270 E. 29th Place, Eugene, also members of the sponsoring church.

Both families have high-school age children.

This fall, Yvon will be a senior at South Eugene High School where he is a member of the International Relations League. At United Lutheran, he is a member of Luther League. He may be able to remain in

the United States to attend college after graduation from high school.

In the Congo, Yvon believes, high school students have a heavier course load than in American schools, and "you really have to study there if you want to pass."

The year before he came to the United States, Yvon—who

speaks French as a native tongue—took courses in English, German, French, mathematics, physics, physical education, art, music and geography.

This type of program, he feels, gives students a "broader background" and results in a good understanding of the world.

And in the Congo, Yvon observed, many churchgoers are not members of the church they attend, but still regularly support the church and are active in its program. In the United States, he notes, many church members are not active in either financial support or church programs.

In the Congo, Yvon has five sisters and two brothers. His father is chairman of the Congo Polytechnic Institute in Leopoldville.

This past year, Yvon said, 171 young people participated in the exchange program, which is sponsored by a number of denominations.

With the exception of the students from the Congo, the participants lived for one year in a foreign country with a family and attended school there.

The Congolese students, he said, will remain in their exchange countries for a longer period of time.

Murder Trial Repeats Tonight

Television viewers enter the minds of three jurors requested to return a verdict of murder in the first degree in tonight's Defenders show at 8:30 on Channel 6.

Mady Lorne, played by Vivica Lindfors, is on trial for murder and the 12 carefully selected jurors are to decide her fate. There's more fun than suspense in this repeat showing of "The Locked Room" as the jurors visualize the killing through their own emotional experience.

Burger disqualifies himself and recommends Mason as the lawyer. There's a nice scene when Lt. Tragg becomes shocked at the friendship between Mason and Burger.

8:30 p.m., The Tall Man (13-8) — Henry Steward, insanely jealous of his beautiful wife, frames her on a murder charge when her former classmate, Sheriff Pat Garrett, expresses friendly interest in her.

9:30 p.m., Play of the Week (2) — "Juno and the Paycock" the story of a mother's struggle to keep her rebellious family together, featuring Hume Cronyn and Walter Matthau. Drama dealing with modern Irish life is an expose of the revolt against poverty and authority in Ireland in 1920.
