California Firm Buys Zilka, Smither

Zilka, Smither & Co., an Oregon investment firm with a branch in Eugene at 933 Pearl St., has been purchased for an unannounced price by the First California Co.—a similar investment firm with headquarters in San Francisco.

The Zilka, Smither brokerage has operated a Eugene branch for the past 30 years, according to Jack Danby, a vice president of the Oregon firm and manager of the Eugene branch.

Announcement of the purchase was made jointly this week by John F. Egan, president of First California, and three officers in Zilka, Smither—James H. Zilka, president, Henry J. Zilka and Arthur W. Smither, board chairman.

55-Year History

Zilka, Smither & Co. was established in Oregon 55 years ago. Besides the Eugene office, it has operated offices in Portland, Salem, Corvallis and Medford. First California Co. was

started in 1919. Beside its San Francisco offices it operates in Los Angeles and 23 other California cities.

Offices in the five Oregon cities will continue to operate without change in management, Danby said, except they will now be able to offer increased services through First California's extensive research and trading departments.

First California is a member of the Pacific Coast Stock Exchange and the Midwest Stock

Exchange, and is an associate member of the American Stock Exchange.

Stock Sold

All stock — held by seven stockholders in Zilka, Smither & Co.—was sold to First California, Danby said.

Five Zilka, Smither officers have been appointed to offices in First California. They are James H. and Henry J. Zilka (senior vice president) and Elbert H. Greene, all of Portland; Arthur W. Smither (senior vice president) and Harold Smither of Salem.

Danby has been named an assistant vice president. Others appointed to similar positions are Frank Calise of Portland, Ralph Smither of Salem and Richard Watson of Medford.

Steel Firms Change Pleas

NEW YORK (AP)—Three steel companies, including two of the nation's biggest, asked federal court Wednesday for permission to change their pleas to price-fixing charges from innocent to no contest.

The companies were U.S. Steel Corp., Bethlehem Steel Co. and the Erie Forge & Steel Corp. of Erie, Pa.

Two individual defendants, Emil Lang, board chairman of Erie Forge, and Homer Lackey, president of Erie Forge, made the same move.

Four steel corporations, five executives and a trade association were indicted April 26, charged with conspiring between 1948 and 1961 to fix prices and rig bids in sales of steel forgings to the Army, Navy, electrical companies and other purchasers.
