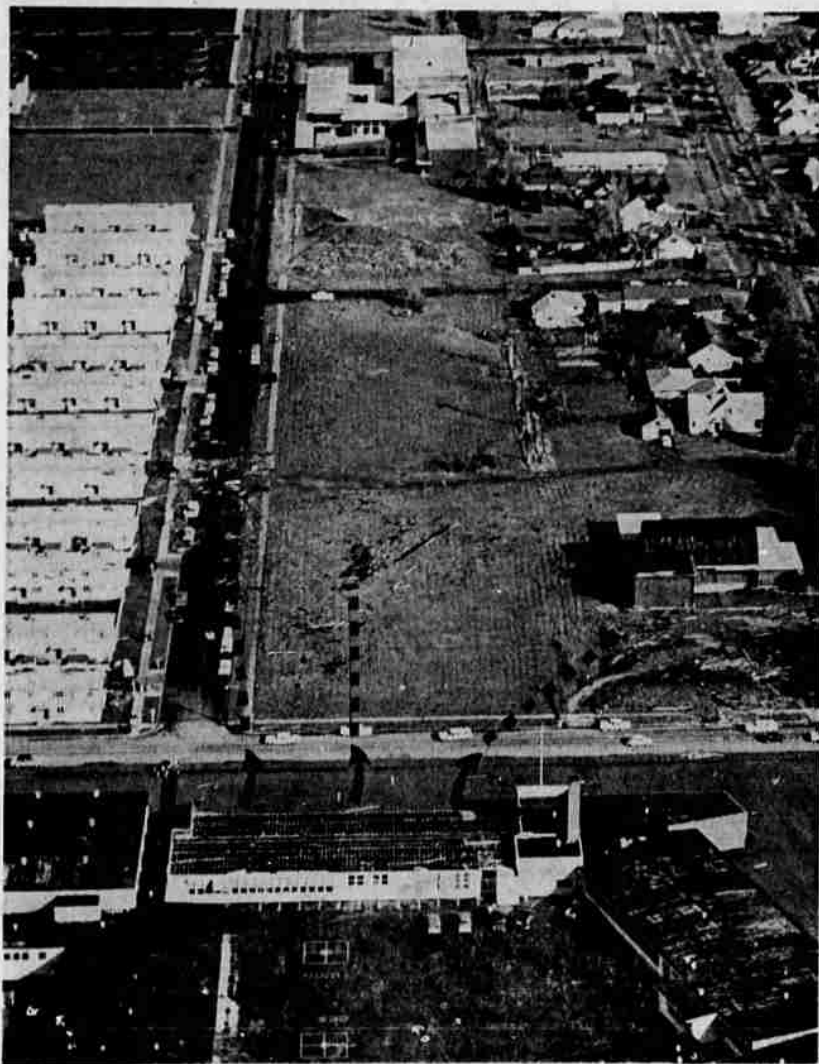
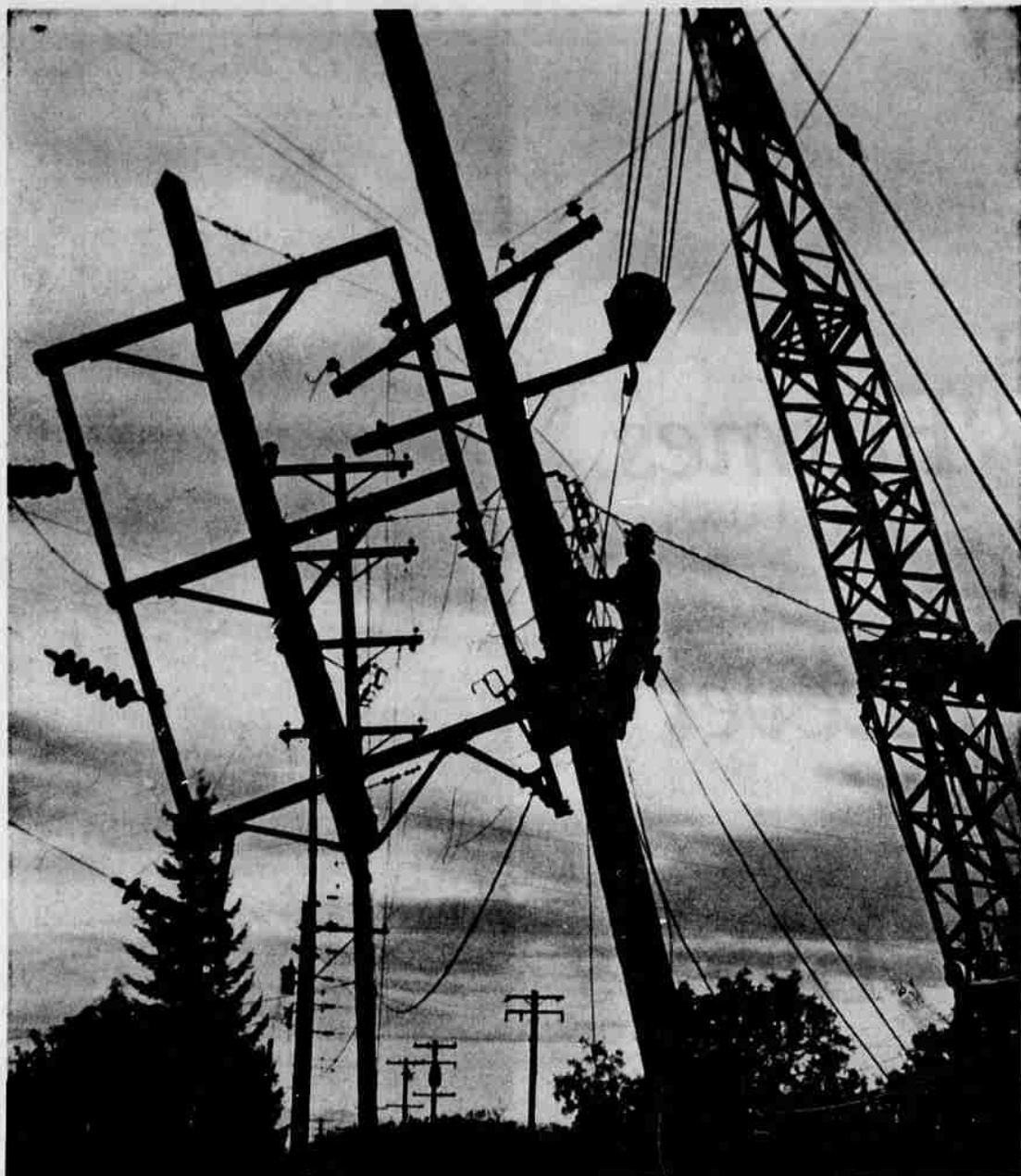


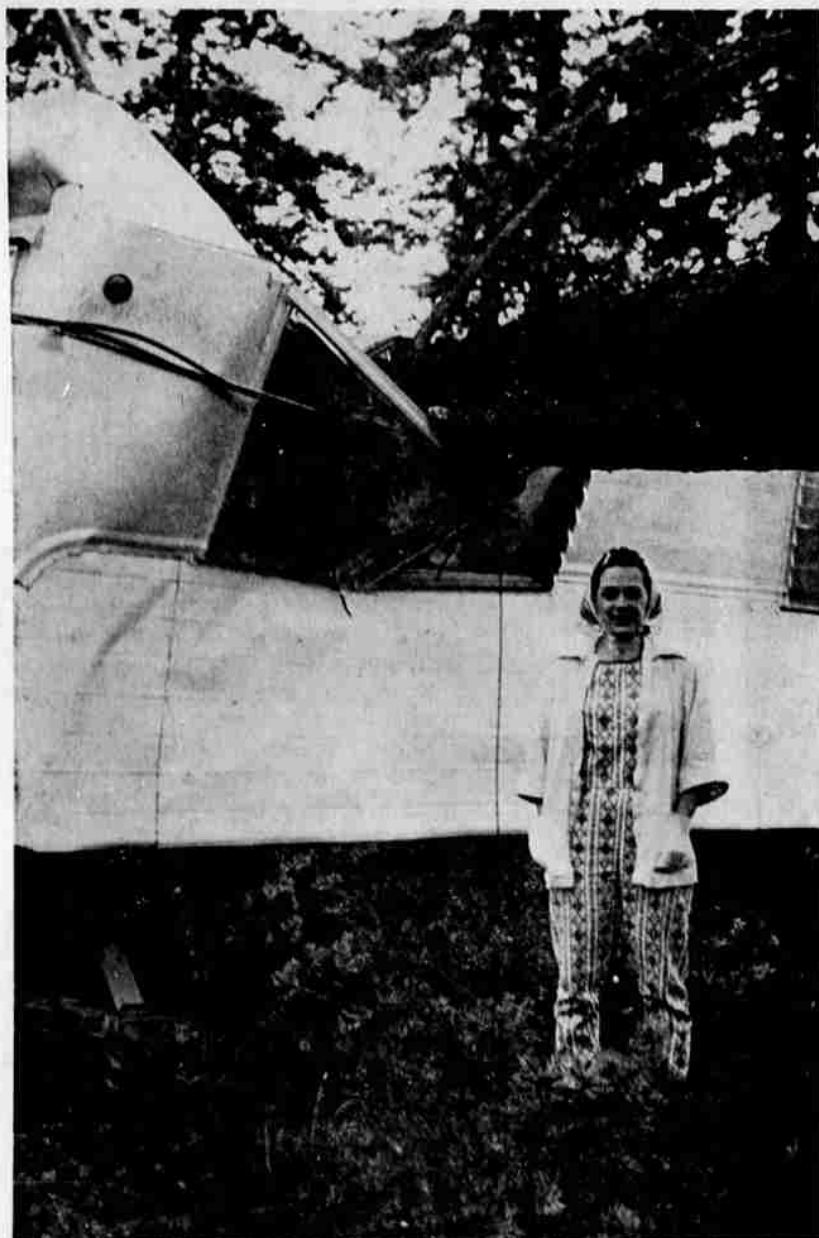
The Morning After...
