'63 Autos Spotlighted Tonight

Cars make news tonight as one television program displays all the new 1963 models and another questions whether cars are a luxury or necessity.

At 6 p.m., on Channels 13 and 8, Chet Huntley, Merrill Mueller, Hugh Downs and "at Fontaine will conduct a tour of the Automobile Show's seven-acre spread in Detroit's Cobo Hall. New models of cars and trucks by all the automobile manufacturers, exhibits of vehicle safety and discussions of future designs in cars highlight the "44th National Automobile Show."

At 9:30 on Channel 9 and 10:30 on Channel 12, "Howard K. Smith" features the subject "Is the American Car a Necessity or a Luxury?" Discussing the design, safety and function of the newest models on the market with Smith are a designer, manufacturer, editor, publicist and author.

Other Sunday previews:

11:30 a.m., Politics '62 (9)—Former President Dwight D. Eisenhower is asked the same general question put to President Kennedy last week on the 1962 campaign issues.

12 p.m., Direction '63 (9)—In this continued study of communism and Christianity, clergymen discuss and evaluate activities of the extreme right wing in handling the Communist threat.

4:30 p.m., KVAL News Special (13)—Live discussion with members of the Fraternal Order of Lumbermen on forest products industry and its importance to the Oregon economy will be presented. Special guest will be Dick Clark, state chairman of the National Forest Products Week, which starts today. John Doyle of KVAL will be program host.

5 p.m., Ballot Box (13)—State ballot measures 2, 3, 4 and 6 will be discussed. Measure 2, 3, and 4 regarding debt limitations, will be discussed by Eugene attorney Douglas Spencer. Measure 6, regarding daylight saving time, will be discussed by Ken Rinke of Portland and R. E. Kerr, Eugene. Moderator for the discussions will be Mrs. A. W. Roecker, of the Eugene League of Women Voters.

6 p.m., Twentieth Century (6)—In this repeat showing, a

group of men called the "Recon Marines" train in New London, Conn., and in St. Thomas in the Virgin Islands. The program shows how the men must master all the skills of paratroopers, frogmen and commandos.

9:30 p.m., GE True (6)—Part one of a two-part series in which Jack Webb plays the role of a Marine about to blow up a Nazi chemical plant in Norway.

10 p.m., DuPont Show (13-8)—Franchot Tone, Maureen Stapleton, Margaret O'Brien and a host of other stars in "The Betrayal," the story of a young man's treachery during a student rebellion against communism in East Berlin.

4:30 p.m., (2) — "Stand Up And Cheer." Warner Baxter, Madge Evans, James Dunn. Crazy depression musical which has the President creating a cabinet post for the secretary of amusement in the hope of laughing the depression away. Occasionally amusing but terribly dated. (1934—fair).
