Bernstein to 'Sound' Center

"The Sound of a hall" is the title of the premier of the sixth season of "Young People's Concert" which will be telecast tonight at 7:30 on Channel 6.

Leonard Bernstein describes the acoustical problems of Lincoln Center's new Philharmonic Hall to his youthful audience. The youngsters and television viewers will be given information on "reverberations," "direct" and "reflected" sounds: the effect of physics, mathematics, carpets, walls, wood and people on the sounds the audience hears; and the feel of a new home to the orchestra.
