Move Could Break Deadlock

Tshombe Offers Mine Money

WASHINGTON (AP) — A new conciliatory move by Moise Tshombe, president of secessionist Katanga Province, could lead to a break in the deadlock over unification of the Congo, U.S. officials said Saturday.

But the U.S. government fears Tshombe may be seeking primarily to stall off the threat of economic sanctions against his mineral-rich province. They indicate that real progress toward a Congo settlement must be made in a few weeks if stronger pressures are not to be imposed. One reason for growing U.S. concern is the belief that the Soviet Union will make a new bid

to establish a power position in the Central African nation unless the Congo government of Premier Cyrille Adoula has its political position reinforced by success of the unity drive.

Tshombe Proposal

Conditionally, Tshombe proposed in a letter to the United Nations last Wednesday that foreign exchange earnings of the big mining corporation, Union Miniere du Haut Katanga, be turned over to the Adoula government rather than Tshombe's Katanga regime.

Getting the Union Miniere foreign exchange payments into the hands of the central government has been a major objective of U.N. Secretary-General U Thant under a unity plan which Thant put forth last August. Tshombe's move appears to be a concession under the Thant plan but Washington officials see a possibility that Tshombe may stall negotiations which are still necessary to work out details of the proposal.

Among other things, Tshombe and Adoula will have to agree on the proportion of the \$120

million of foreign exchange which the central government would pass on to Katanga. Also involved is the question of the division of the \$40 million annual Union Miniere tax payment which has recently gone to Katanga but under a new arrangement would be divided between Katanga and the central government.

Integration of Forces

Other issues which will have to be settled before Katanga is considered to be a part of a proposed new Congo federation include integration of the armed forces of the province into the forces of the central government.

Union Miniere has a foreign exchange income of about \$200 million a year. Of that total about 40 per cent or \$80 million stays in Belgium where the company processes Katanga copper and cobalt. The net foreign exchange turned over to the Congo therefore would be about \$120 million a year.
