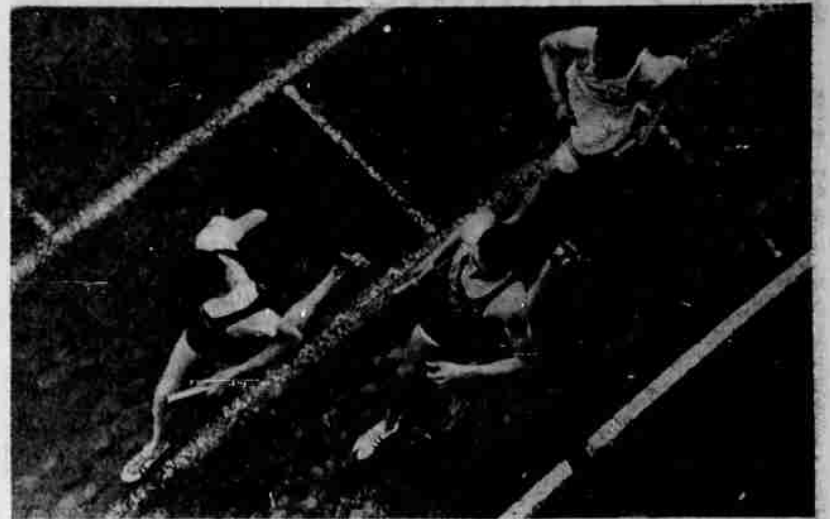




Miler Don Mast Shows a Mud-Blot Pattern After Anchoring Myrtle Point in Distance Medley

Cobras Retain Title; Chiefs Win Class C

Central Linn has held on to its Class B title in the Hayward Relays but Rogue River has rudely unseated perennial champion St. Mary's of Medford in Class C.
It took victory in the final event Friday to give Central Linn a repeat title while Rogue River was waiting to see an easy triumph.
If it had been a horse race, the charts would have listed the conditions as sloppy, if not worse.
As a result of the rains that left water standing on the track, not a record was broken and only one tied—that an 11-foot, 6-inch pole vault in Class C by Don Salyer of Rogue River.
The big schools were hoping for better conditions Saturday as Class A and Metro teams battled for the titles won last year by South Salem and Cottage Grove.
Rogue River, which got six

firsts including two from Salyer, scored 68½ points to take the Class C title while Mapleton was taking second with 24 and St. Mary's third with 21.
Central Linn, disappointed because the shuttle hurdles—a strong event for the Cobras—was called off because of the in-field conditions, grabbed the sprint medley for the Class B championship.
St. Francis followed with 25 and Reedsport 23½.
St. Francis, which won both the distance medley and two-mile relay along with the high jump with George May, led by a half-point going into the sprint event. But the Saints did not place in the top six.
It was Salyer, who has cleared 12 feet in the pole vault, who grabbed the individual honors. In addition to the 11-6 in the pole vault, he won the high hurdles in a remarkable 15.5 and was second in the high jump at 5-8.
St. Francis, anchored by Bob

Williams' 4:37.3 mile after Randy Taylor had gone 2:02.9 in the 880, easily whipped favored Reedsport with a 11:13.7 clocking in the distance medley.
Reedsport, with Gene Faircloth finishing with a 4:40.8 mile, was far back in second with 11:28.3.
Taylor came back with a 2:05.2 anchor half-mile as St. Francis captured the two-mile in 8:40.6.
The lone individual double winner in the Class B competition was John McKern of Central Linn with heaves of 50-8¼ in the shot put and 143-8 in the discus.
Don Goertzen of Sutherlin joined the fast-growing list of prep vaulters who have cleared 12 feet this year when he won the Class B vault by going a half-inch over 12 feet.
Not only did Salyer win two individual events but Rogue River won every relay event—distance medley, 440, two-mile and sprint medley.
