House Okays Wedding Bill

SALEM — The House passed and sent to the Senate Saturday a bill requiring the approval of a judge for issuance of a marriage license to a girl under 17 or a boy under 19.

The bill had been before the House previously requiring the approval of a circuit judge for such marriages.

But Eastern Oregon representatives protested that this would work a hardship on sparsely-populated areas, particularly Eastern Oregon, where circuit judges cover several counties.

The bill passed Saturday would allow county judges to give the necessary consent.

Rep. Grace Peck, one of the measure's sponsors, said the bill was an attempt to curb ill-advised and hasty marriages, particularly in the case where the girl is pregnant.

It was recommended by the Legislative Interim Committee on Social Problems.

Rep. Shirley Field, R-Portland, said she would support the bill, because "I think we should do anything we can to slow the rate of young marriages."

Plans are for apartment, retirement homes and a motel.



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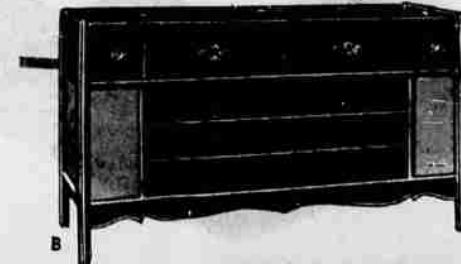
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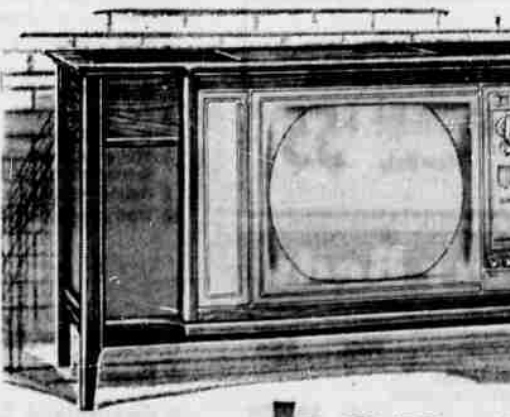
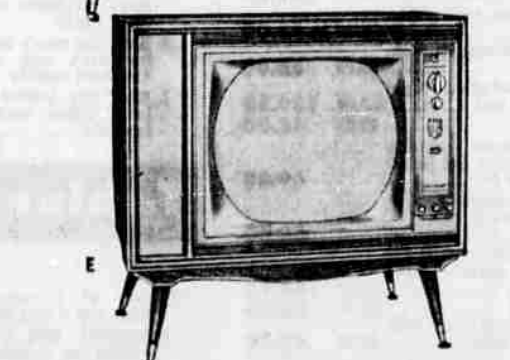
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
