An Open House on the Metropolitan Transportation Plan update is scheduled for Wednesday, November 16, 2011, from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., with a Public Meeting immediately following beginning at 6:30 p.m., at the Vancouver Community Library’s Columbia Room, 901 C Street, Vancouver, Washington. Public participation is welcomed and encouraged.

The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) announces the release of its Fall 2011 Affordable Rental Housing Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). In keeping with PHB’s mission, the funds will be used to preserve, rehabilitate and/or develop housing that helps “solve the unmet housing needs of the people of Portland.” Investment priorities are for rental housing affordable to households with incomes no greater than 60% of Area Median Family Income (MFI). While all housing units funded through the NOFA must serve households at or below 60% median income, those projects that propose additional units serving households at or below 30% MFI, while still maintaining financial feasibility initially and over time, are preferred. The NOFA documents, including the amounts of funding available, are posted on PHB’s website at <http://www.portlandonline.com/PHB/RFP>
