nor Governor Reagan nor I ever raised a single dollar from them to run against each other in the general election. Sadly, all of that has changed. What this massive infusion of more money into the political campaign has caused is a mammoth increase in negative ads. That's a tragedy, in my opinion, and a step backwards for the political system of our country.

JC: Well, I'm not a political strategist, and I'm certainly not one for the Republican Party.
