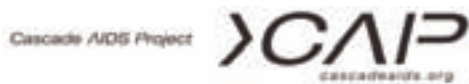

### TOWN OF LAKEVIEW GEOTHERMAL HEATING PROJECT

Separate sealed bids for the construction of a geothermal piping system will be received by Ray Simms, Manager, at Town Hall, 525 North 1st Street, Oregon, 97630, until **2:00 P.M., local time, March 21, 2013 and then at said location publicly opened and read aloud. Contractor has the option to bid on drilling and testing the wells phase ONLY, installation of the pipe and related work phase ONLY, or both phases of the project consisting of the wells and the pipe installation.** The First-Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Form, which is submitted separately, is required at **4:00 PM on March 21, 2013.** The bids shall be mailed or delivered; fax transmissions or e-mails will not be accepted.

Generally the work consists of three 6" monitoring wells; a 600 foot re-injection well; a 700 foot production well; installation of 22,937 feet of 6" insulated geothermal pipe; installation of 5,493 feet of 4" insulated geothermal pipe (GEOTHERMAL PIPE WILL BE SUPPLIED BY THE OWNER); telemetry controls; well house construction ; pumping equipment and related work.

The Contract Documents may be examined at Town Hall, 525 North 1st Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, and Anderson Engineering & Surveying, Inc., 17681 Highway 395, Lakeview, Oregon 97630.

Hard copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained at the Issuing Office of Anderson Engineering and Surveying, Inc., P.O. Box 28, 17681 Hwy 395, Lakeview, OR 97630, for the nonrefundable **pre-paid cost of \$100.00** per set. Electronic copies can be sent upon arrangement with the Issuing Office.

Bidders must be pre-qualified. Bidders must submit by mail or deliver the Contractor's Pre- Qualification Form, which is included in the contract documents, or the State of Oregon Department of Administrative Services Pre- Qualification Application Form on or before the Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference of **March 6, 2013.** Fax or e-mail transmissions of Pre-Qualification Forms will only be accepted with written verification from the Issuing Office of receipt of documents.

The entire Bidding Packet, which accompanies the Contract Documents, must be submitted or the bidder will be considered non-responsive.

This is a public works contract and no bid will be received or considered by the public contracting agency unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder, as part of their/his/her bid that the provisions of ORS 279.350 (Prevailing Wage Rates) are to be complied with. A copy of the Prevailing Wage Rate Statement is included in the Contract Documents.

No bids will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided upon the bid form provided by the owner and accompanied by the bid bond or a certified check executed in favor of the owner in an amount not less than 5% of the total amount of the bid. Bid bond or check will be forfeited should the selected bidder neglect or refuse to enter into contract and provide suitable bond for faithful performance of the work.

The successful bidder shall provide a performance and payment bond, as hereinafter stipulated, for the full amount of the contract within 10 days of the Notice of Award and/or with the contracts.

No bidder may withdraw or modify their bid after the hour set for the opening thereof until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening. Owner may waive any bid that is considered nonresponsive due to the lack of all required bidding documents. Owner may waive any informality in the bidding process.

There will be a **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Conference March 6, 2013 at the Town Hall Annex, 525 North St Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, at 2:00 PM. ## CITIZEN REVIEW COMMITTEE MEMBERS

The Portland City Auditor's Independent Police Review (IPR) division is responsible for the civilian oversight of the Portland Police Bureau (Police Bureau). The Citizen Review Committee (CRC) is an advisory body to IPR and the Police Bureau.

CRC holds appeal hearings of police misconduct investigations; listens to community concerns; engages in trainings to increase cultural awareness; reviews Police Bureau policies; and advises IPR on complaint handling processes.

CRC members are appointed by Portland City Council to serve three-year terms.

Candidates must be Portland, Oregon, residents or business owners, and be impartial and objective without bias regarding law enforcement.
