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of the human experience in a way which resonates with oppressed people of other cultures?

BG: I would hope so. I would hope that while we made a movie about faith, that it's not necessarily only about Catholicism. And I'd also hope that the notion of disillusionment wouldn't be seen as the exclusive province of the Irish. The context is the Irish landscape, and the Irish story of the moment, with all of the treachery in terms of the spiritual, economic and political leadership. There have been horrible shortcomings, with hurt and pain

being inflicted upon people. But I don't think that's exclusive to the Irish. Many people find it difficult to believe in leadership anymore. What do you replace it with, though? That's kind of what the movie's all about. The idea of replacing flawed leadership with cynicism and despair isn't a barrel of laughs, either. So, I hope the film is thought-provoking in a generalized way as opposed as to being read as simply specific to the Irish point-of-view.

Lease Crutcher Lewis, LLC, serving as the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) on the Roosevelt High School Modernization Project for Portland Public Schools (PPS) is soliciting proposals from qualified Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, and Fire Sprinkler Subcontractors for the preconstruction services and construction of the Roosevelt High School Modernization in Portland, Oregon. Terms and conditions of the proposal are outlined in Lease Crutcher Lewis, LLC (CM/GC) "Request for Proposal", dated July 25 2014, attached to and made a part of the Contract Documents.

Proposals will be received at the offices of Lease Crutcher Lewis, LLC, (CM/GC), 550 SW 12th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97205, until 2:00 P.M. PST, August 15, 2014 at which time the proposals will be opened with a PPS representative present. Proposals shall be clearly marked "Roosevelt High School Modernization"

The total building construction cost is projected to be approximately \$65 Million. The MEP scope of work is currently at a schematic design level, without fully defined costs.

The scope of work for this proposal includes mechanical, plumbing, electrical (inclusive of low voltage), and fire sprinkler work only (Design-Build only for fire sprinklers) for the construction of a new 3 story 85,000 SF gymnasium building, and new 2 story 75,000 SF performing arts building with full performance theater, remodel of existing theater into a new library and classroom spaces, full remodel and seismic upgrade to the existing 1921 building, and demolition of the existing cafeteria / kitchen building, existing gym and classroom building, existing boiler building, existing arts building, and existing shop building. In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 580-063-0020, Lewis will use the request for proposals (RFP) competitive procurement process to select and enter into a Contract with Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, and Fire Sprinkler firms. Plumbing and Mechanical RFPs may be submitted by companies individually or as a single package. Either way, costs must be separated by scope of work into Plumbing and Mechanical sections.

Lewis intends to enter into a contract with the selected firms for work that will initially include Preconstruction Phase Services only. There are provisions for adding Construction Phase Services at the sole discretion of Lewis through acceptance of a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) by contract amendment.

Lewis, in partnership with Portland Public Schools and Bassetti Architects will evaluate each Proposal with respect to the evaluation criteria outlined in the Lease Crutcher Lewis, LLC (CM/GC) "Request for Proposal", dated July 25, 2014. At its sole discretion, Lewis may elect to short list and interview finalists in order to more fully understand the relative qualifications.

This RFP does not commit Lewis to enter into any agreement, to pay any expenses incurred in preparation of any response to this request, or to procure or contract for any supplies, goods or services. Lewis reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals not in compliance with the RFP or if it is in the public interest to do so.

A mandatory pre-bid conference for Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, and Fire Sprinkler Subcontractors will be held at the Project Site, 6941 N Central Street, Portland, OR, at the main entry steps, located at the intersection of Central Ave. and Ida Street in Portland, Oregon on August 1, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. PST.

All proposers must comply with the following requirements: Prevailing Wage Law, ORS 279C.800-279C.870, and be licensed with the Construction Contractors Board, ORS 671.530. Bidder shall indicate Resident Status per ORS 279A.120. If Required, Proposers must obtain business licenses to perform work in the City of Portland prior to mobilizing on jobsite.

Proposals will not be considered unless RECEIVED by 2:00 P.M. PST on August 15, 2014, and fully completed in the manner provided by the "Instructions to Proposers".
