Free Back-to-School Vaccinations Available in Clark County

Preparing for school means gathering supplies and backpacks. It's also the perfect time to make sure children are up to date on their vaccines. Vaccinations are required for school.

Call a health care provider now to make an appointment. All vaccines required for school are free for those up to age 19. Some providers may charge an administrative fee. Parents who can't afford the fee may ask to have it waived. Families without a regular

health care provider may call the following clinics, which offer free back-to-school vaccinations. Please be sure to bring immunization records.

Free Clinic of SW Washington: 4100 Plomondon St., Vancouver, (360) 313-1390. Wednesday, Aug. 27, 1 - 7 p.m. and every 1st and 3rd Wednesday, 5 - 7 p.m. Walk-in, uninsured children only.

Sea Mar Community Health Centers: 7140 E. Delaware Lane, Vancouver,

(360) 566-4410; call for appointment, Wednesday, Aug. 13, 8 - noon. Some adult vaccines also available at no cost.

Battle Ground High School: 400 W. Main St., Battle Ground, (360) 566-4410; call for appointment. Friday, Aug. 22, 3 - 5:45 p.m. Children only, to age 18.

Lacamas Medical Group: 3240 N.E. 3rd Ave, Camas, (360) 838-2440, Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2 - 6 p.m. Walk-in, Grades 1 - 12.

Children who aren't fully immunized may be sent home from school if a disease outbreak occurs. Most students in Washington have vaccinations needed to enter school.
