Facsimile and electronic proposals will not be accepted. Farmers Irrigation District may decline to consider proposals submitted after the above stated deadline. Any statements made by Farmers Irrigation District representatives, agents, or employees at the pre-proposal site examination or conference are not binding on the District unless confirmed by written addendum to the Contract Documents.

A link to an FTP site containing the Contract Documents will be provided after the payment has been processed. 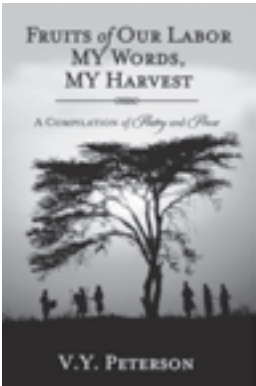
