Fresh and fruity ways to impress guests

- Juice from 1/2 lime

- 2 (1-inch) slices Bosc pear (cut lengthwise)
- 1 ounce simple syrup

1 1/2-2 ounces club soda

Place mint sprigs, lime juice, honeydew melon, pear and simple syrup in cocktail shaker. Muddle lightly. Add white wine and ice. Shake vigorously. Strain into tall glass over fresh ice. Top with club soda. Garnish with additional mint sprig.



Perfectly Pink Punch

- 1 (15 ounce) can mandarin oranges in light syrup
- 1 cup fresh or frozen raspberries, thawed
- Juice from 1/2 lemon
- 1 ounce simple syrup
- 1 (750 milliliter) bottle Barefoot Refresh Perfectly Pink
- Club soda (optional)

The Urban League of Portland seeks to provide a framework that will allow East County Communities to overcome barriers and gain equity," the Urban League says in a press statement.
