plishments, Obama acknowledged that there was still a lot of work to do particularly on the issues of homelessness, job creation, income inequality and gun violence.

“After I leave office, I intend to continue to work with organizations and citizens doing good across the country on these and other pressing issues to build on the progress that we’ve made,” said Obama.

Nationally, Democrats have lost more than 1,000 elected seats since Obama took office. Democrats also serve

those communities,” said Obama. “And I’ve seen that when we are in those communities, it makes a difference.”

Obama continued: “That’s how I became President. I became a U.S. senator not just because I had a strong base in Chicago, but because I was driving around downstate Illinois and going to fish fries and sitting in VFW halls and talking to farmers.”

In the 2016 presidential election, Trump was able to win the counties of Erie, Northampton and Luzerne in Pennsylvania; three counties

shortest life expectancy compared to other groups.”

Obama also noted that his administration, over the last eight years, has dramatically decreased the number of troops deployed abroad and eliminated Osama Bin Laden as well as thousands of other terrorists.

“No foreign terrorist organization has successfully executed an attack on our homeland that was directed from overseas,” said Obama.

Obama continued: “Through diplomacy, we’ve ensured that Iran cannot obtain a nuclear weapon – without going to war with Iran. We opened up a new chapter with the people of Cuba. And we brought nearly 200 nations together around a climate agreement that could very well save this planet for our kids.”

CITIZEN REVIEW COMMITTEE RECRUITMENT

CRC members are appointed by Portland City Council to serve three-year terms.
