ty asked secretaries of state to provide, by July 14, voters' information including birthdates, the last four digits of their Social Security numbers, about felony convictions and military status, party affiliations, what elections they voted in since 2006, and voter registration in other states.

Richardson wrote in response that "any person may receive a statewide list of electors upon payment of \$500."

Kobach had said the data he sought will help the commission "fully analyze vulnerabilities and issues related to voter registration and voting."

Trump, who lost the popular vote in the 2016 presidential election, created the commission through an executive order in May. He has said voter fraud existed in the election that he won by Electoral College votes.

The Associated Press reported Saturday that Trump is upset that all states — including blue states like California and New York, as well as

conservative states such as Texas — aren't fully cooperating with his voting commission's request for detailed information about every voter in the United States.

"Numerous states are refusing to give information to the very distinguished VOTER FRAUD PANEL. What are they trying to hide?" Trump said in a tweet Saturday.

The City of Tigard will receive sealed Bids from qualified firms at Tigard City Hall's Utility Billing Counter (Attention: Joe Barrett, Sr. Management Analyst) located at 13125 SW Hall Blvd., Tigard, Oregon 97223 until 2:00 pm local time, Thursday, July 27, 2017 for the Main Street at Fanno Creek Properties Demolition project. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud immediately after the Bid Closing time and date at Tigard City Hall.

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 10:00 AM, local time on July 18, 2017 at 12533 SW Main St, Tigard, Oregon, 97223.

The project generally consists of the following:

1. Mobilization.
2. Temporary signage, protection and traffic control.
3. Erosion control and cleanup.
4. Asbestos, hazardous building material removal and disposal.
5. Demolition, deconstruction, recycling and disposal of existing buildings.
6. Transportation and disposal of contaminated hazardous and non-hazardous soils.
7. Structural fill.
8. Performance of additional and incidental work as called for by specifications and plans.

Basis of Bid Award shall incorporate all items identified on the Bid Schedule.

Pursuant to Tigard Public Contracting Rule 30.055, all Bidders must submit a Bid security to the City along with their Bid in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of their Bid. Because the City's estimate of contract value exceeds \$100,000, Bidders must submit a First Tier Sub-contractor Disclosure Form, provided in this Bid Booklet, to the City no later than 4:00 pm local time, Thursday, July 27, 2017

The provisions of ORS Chapters 279A and 279C and all other Oregon and Federal provisions pertaining to minimum salaries and wages shall be incorporated by reference as if fully set forth in any Contract resulting from this Advertisement for Bid. Contractor shall provide proof to the City prior to the beginning of any of the work that the Contractor has filed a public works bond with a corporate surety in the amount of \$30,000 with the Construction Contractors Board as required under Oregon Prevailing Wage Rate (PWR) law.

Successful Contractor shall be encouraged to offer job shadowing, mentorship, and training opportunities, and request a preference for hiring graduates of Oregon Tradeswomen, Inc. (a current EPA Environmental Worker Training grant recipient) as part of this work. Successful Contractor shall also be encouraged to maximize recycling of the demolition materials.

No Bid will be considered unless fully completed in a manner provided in the Bid Packet. Facsimile and electronic (email) Bids will not be accepted nor will Bids be accepted after the stated Bid Closing. Bids received after the Bid Closing will be returned to the submitting firm unopened after a Contract has been awarded for the required services.
