Two of those could be Florida Sens. Marco Rubio and Bill Nelson. Bastien is urging Rubio and Nelson to protect the

thousands of TPS recipients in Florida and to remind the rest of the country of the importance of Haitians and Salvadorans in the immigration debate.

Rubio, wrote an opinion article in the Miami

Herald lauding Haitians' contributions to Florida's economy.

Still, neither Rubio nor Nelson has introduced legislation or signed onto bills to protect those

immigrant groups.

Antonio Woodbridge said he and his wife came to the United States to escape natural disaster and political turmoil in El Salvador following

its earthquake in 2001. Woodbridge, who works as a detailer in an auto mechanic facility in northern Virginia is a

member of the national TPS Alliance that connects TPS recipients from all recipient countries.
