the conservative jurist, Democrats struggled to unify behind a clear and coherent message to combat the nomination, which could shift the court to the right for decades.

They're energized, outraged and ready to fight. But what, exactly, is their argument to voters?

MoveOn's Washington director Ben Wikler, who was among hundreds of liberal activists protesting outside the Supreme Court, acknowledged Democrats were far from unified behind a simple message to rally voters against Trump's selection.

Kavanaugh's Views of Presidential Power Drawing Questions

WASHINGTON (AP) — Supreme Court nominee Brett Kavanaugh's past writings that a president should not be distracted by lawsuits and investigations could become a flashpoint in what's already shaping up to be a contentious confirmation battle.

With special counsel Robert Mueller investigating whether President Donald Trump obstructed justice, questions about whether a chief executive can be subpoenaed or indicted could potentially reach the Supreme Court. Though there's no indication at this point that will happen, it's sure to be a major topic of questioning at Kavanaugh's confirmation hearing as the Senate weighs whether to confirm him to replace retiring Justice Anthony Kennedy.

Democrats opposing Kavanaugh are already weighing in, saying the past writings — particularly a legal article he wrote on the separation of powers in 2009 — suggest he would be inclined to side with Trump.

Senate Democratic leader Chuck Schumer said Tuesday that he "seems exactly like the kind of man President Trump would want on the Supreme Court if legal issues from the Mueller probe arise."

2016 rather than 2015, Steven Liffel is listed on 10/6/16 rather than 12/5/16, and Billy Simms is listed on July 27, 2012—one day before he was actually shot.

- One duplicate entry gets the suspect's name completely wrong, somehow listing John Bocock (10/12/11) as "Kenneth DeFrees." It is not clear whether this and the four other duplicate entries are there because it is impossible to delete items once they are posted.
- At least two incidents contain no narratives at all: The 2008 Portland shooting of Jason Spoor says "unknown reason for shooting due to date," and the 2016 Sherwood shooting of James Tylka simply states "homicide suspect."
- While some high-profile cases such as the Umpqua Community College shooter (who reportedly committed suicide) are included, others — such as the

deaths of Christopher Kalonji and Lavoy Finicum in January 2016 are not.

- At least two Portland incidents are not listed: The death in custody of Darris Johnson in July 2011, and the death of Craig Boehler in November 2010; the police say Boehler died of smoke inhalation rather than their bullets.
- The narrative for the Portland Police shooting of Kelly Swoboda lists the "crime reason" as "warrant service," even though they were looking for a suspicious person and did not have a warrant.
- While several suspects are listed as being "Black or African American," none (including Santiago Cisneros, shot in Portland in 2013) are listed as Latino.

willing to wait to be paid, and even gave his nephew a car for free.

Cash has been unemployed, but it isn't for a lack of trying. His luck changes when, despite being caught lying on his resume' during a job interview, he's hired anyway because the interviewer admired his ingenuity. The hope is that he'd bring the same ambition to his entry level gig as a telemarketer.

It's impressed upon Cash during his training to "stick to the script," if he wants to succeed. Plus, he gets

a valuable tip from an African American colleague (Danny Glover) in the neighboring cubicle, namely: "Use your White voice."

Between dropping his Black accent and following the company's guidelines, Cash earns a coveted promotion to "power caller." Suddenly, he's making enough money to pay off Uncle Sergio, buy a new car and move into a fancy flat in an upscale neighborhood.

Unfortunately, the raise proves to be a mixed blessing for Cash. First, it creates tension between him and the buddies he left behind on the floor of the crowded call center, since they're still making min-

imum wage and are in the midst of organizing a union over the objections of management. And then his politically active performance artist girlfriend is disappointed when he crosses the picket line and dubs him a "scab."

Thus unfolds "Sorry to Bother You," a thought-provoking social satire marking the scriptwriting and directorial debut of Boots Riley. If the name rings a bell, that's because he's better known as the founder of the radical hip hop group, The Coup, as well as one of the most dynamic leaders of the Occupy Oakland Movement kickstarted back in 2011.

The film certainly reflects Boots' far-left leanings, but is clever and entertaining enough to recommend even to members of the 1 percent!
