Celebrated Author Ntozake Shange Dies at 70

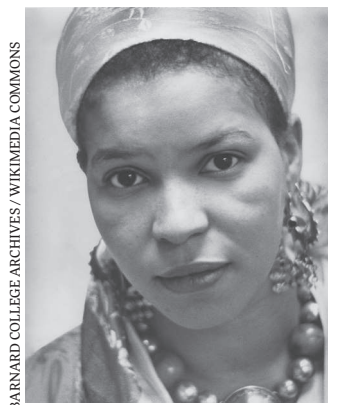

Pioneering poet and playwright Ntozake Shange died on the morning of Oct. 27 at an assisted living facility in Bowie, Maryland. She was best known for

her much celebrated Obie Award-winning play, "For Colored Girls Who Have Considered Suicide/When the Rainbow is Enuf."
