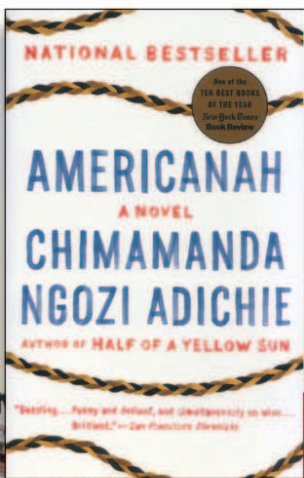

Nigerian Dance Party

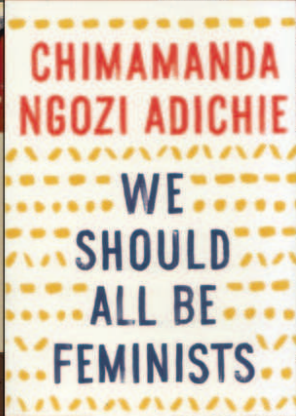
Sat., Jan. 12, 3–4 pm, Midland Library
