She later divorced and moved to Portland, OR in 1959. She worked hard and became a CNA and worked for OHSU. Years later she hurt her back and worked odd jobs such as bartending to make ends meet. There in Oregon she married Kenny Tompkins, and was a member of New Hope Baptist Church. Years later Jessie divorced Kenny.

Jessie had many caregivers but only liked just a few, Shirley Jones and Amanda Archerd.

Jessie had also become an Eastern Star where she served many seats, the last being Treasurer, well into the 2000's.

Jessie's favorite color was blue. She loved playing Bingo, working on crossword, playing cards, reading gossip magazines such as the "Enquirer." Jessie loved dining out at Denny's Restaurant, she also liked fishing from time to time. After Jessie raised kids, she continued to live in Portland, OR until her passing January 1, 2019. We all loved her so much.

Jessie raised her great niece Diana, who we all know as "Peaches" later also raising her granddaughters Jessherie and

singer and producer used his power and influence to sexually and physically abuse women and young girls.

PEOPLE Magazine editors said they reached out to Kelly's representatives who offered a "no comment" about the series.

In 2002, Kelly, a Chicago native, was indicted after a video surfaced allegedly showing a man engaged in sex acts with a woman who some witnesses testified was 14 at the time of the recording. Both Kelly and the woman denied that the video was of them, and Kelly was never charged with assault. In 2008, Kelly was found not guilty on 21 counts of

child pornography.

Several published reports said Kelly intends to counteract the documentary with lawsuits and the creation of a Facebook page to "expose the lies." However, Hampton said there was plenty of truth attached to the story and much more remains untold.

"When I went into this project, I was clear that he was a predator and that he targeted young and vulnerable girls. I don't think I knew he was an abuser, and I don't mean to sound naive, but I just didn't think physical abuse was a part of his repertoire," Hampton said.

"I certainly didn't know I would have to listen to a woman after woman

talking about being denied food and movement. I mean, we about to get into a couple of episodes where you're going to hear testimony of girls talking about having, you know, they couldn't leave the room unless he told them to and all of them didn't have bathrooms in the room. So, they used slop buckets. His runners would put slop buckets in the room. So, I don't think I was prepared for his sadism."
