deputy assistant attorney general in the Civil Division of the Department of Justice, told the judges that the standard operating procedures are not binding; instead, he said, they are meant only as guidance for examiners who process about 22,000 inquiries per day and about 8.2

million a year. “The SOPs do not create a mandatory requirement that trumps discretionary function,” Ward said. Roof has been sentenced to death in the massacre. The appeals court panel did not indicate when it will issue its ruling.

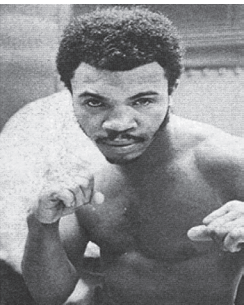
