RULES GOVERNING ENTRIES IN CLASSES 12, 13 AND 14. 1. Any person exhibiting articles obtained from other growers shall forfeit the entrance fee, and no premium shall be awarded to such articles.

2. The name of the exhibitor may be placed on articles for exhibition, and in all cases where a premium is awarded, the name of the variety taking such premium shall be given and published.

3. All entries must be made and all articles must be placed on exhibition before the close of the second day of the fair.

Class XV.—Natural History, Mining Products and Arts.

No. 1.—Natural History.

Table listing various natural history items like Cabinet specimens, native birds and animals of Oregon, Cabinet of minerals and geological specimens of Oregon, etc., with their respective premium amounts.

No. 2.—Mining Products.

Table listing various mining product items like Gold quartz, Coarse gold, Fine gold, Silver ore, Cinabar, Copper and copper ore, Lead display of 1/2 a ton, Coal, etc., with their respective premium amounts.

Table listing various mining product items like Asphaltum, Marble, Granite, Borax, Sulphur, Precious stones, Mineral water, Petrifications, Gypsum, Tin ore, Magnesia, Lime, etc., with their respective premium amounts.

No. 3.—Works of Art.

Table listing various works of art items like Best exhibit mechanical dentistry, Oil painting on canvass, Printing, book work, newspaper, cards, etc., poster in colors, plain, etc., with their respective premium amounts.
