

THE MARKETS.

Commercial.

There is no change in market rates since last week, except a rise in gold at New York and consequent decline in greenbacks here of 90 to 91.

A large number of vessels continue to arrive at Portland to load with wheat and flour, but we understand that some of them were chartered in the first instance by San Francisco houses that have since failed, so they will have to be re-chartered on their arrival at Portland.

The necessity is evident to induce ships to come direct to the Columbia for our next year's crop, so that Oregon wheat may cut its own figure in the world's markets and not pass for a California product. We raise better wheat than they can in California, and the world will never find it out until we ship it direct, and that can only be done when vessels can be loaded below all the river shoals.
