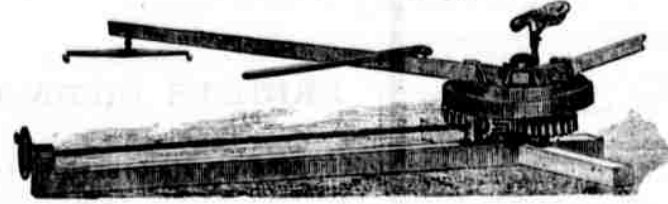
ECONOMY.
