THE NATIONAL GRANGE.

We take from the Patron's Helper the following remarks on the work done by the late National Grange at its session at Cincinnati:

We left the grange in session Tuesday night, Nov. 28, and came back to the old office, very glad indeed to return after our two weeks sojourn in Chicago.

To make a brief review of the work done, we note first the proposed amendments to the constitution, the text of which we publish elsewhere.

The action of the grange on business matters, particularly as to co-operation, is not so clear. The committee submitted a preliminary report, which was cut to pieces pretty badly and then adopted in its mutilated condition.

The following proposed amendments to the constitution of the National Grange, were adopted by a two-thirds vote of the National Grange, at this the tenth annual session, viz:

- No. 1.—To amend article one, section two, by inserting after the word "ballot" the following words: "any fourth degree member in good standing shall be eligible to office, or receive the degree in the county, district, State or national grange, within whose jurisdiction such members may reside, but shall not be entitled to vote."
