The Wheat Market.

Since last week the quotations from Liverpool have advanced somewhat, both for winter and for spring wheat, compared with the week...

As near as we can learn, there are now in the river vessels with capacity to transport 10,000 tons, and half of this amount is already under charter.

Liverpool quotations stand now at about the same figures as last week. Owing to the supply of tonnage and the appearance of the English market, there is no probability of any great change in prices.

Our season is very fine for farmers, while those of California are looking out for rains that do not seem to visit them.

SALEM MARKET.—Butter 37 to 40 cents per lb; eggs, 37 to 40 cents per doz; potatoes, 65 to 70 cents per bushel; hay, \$20 per ton.
