"I have nothing to say," is the only answer he makes to inquiries in his case. He recently received a letter from his wife in Del Norte county, Cal., in which she said she would like very much to come and see him, but as she was busy cooking for a camp of 25 men she could not spare the time. He shows no desire to confess. During his incarceration before the trial he read Scripture, having read the Bible through from end to end. After his conviction he turned to trashy fiction and has developed an appetite for the trashy sort of literature. Sheriff Hiatt is arranging the jail yard and erecting the scaffold for the hanging.
