The controversy over the right to
mine the bars and banks of the riv-
ers of Southern Oregon came to a
head last week in the circuit court
for Josephine county. The contro-
versy has been long pending. It
was some two or three years ago
that James Savage, an old Montana
miner, concluded to test this ques-
tion, says the Southern Oregon
Mining Journal. Savage went be-
low Grant's Pass some six miles
and staked off a claim in the bed of
Rogue river. He erected a wing-
dam and put up a pump operated
by a current wheel to take the wa-
ter out of the enclosure. His efforts
succeeded beyond his anticipations.
As long as the river remained low
he made from \$8 to \$10 a day per

man. Mr. Simpkins, the riparian
proprietor, for awhile looked at the
goings and comings of Mr. Savage
and his employes with some mis-
givings. But when his fences and
gates and pasture lands were in-
vaded he protested. Then Mr.
Woolfolk tried it. He entered on
a bar opposite the lands of Ole
Seaverson, two miles above Grant's
Pass, and erected a wingdam. An
injunction followed. The final de-
cision in this case was given last
week in the circuit court. In de-
ciding the question Judge Hanna
reviewed the several contentions
made by the defendant and sum-
med up his conclusions by the state-
ment that the riparian proprietor
owns the ground as far as the cen-
ter of the stream, and is to be pro-
tected by the courts.

The effect of the decision is this,
that where the banks of a stream
have passed out of the hands of
Uncle Sam and become private
property the miner who proposes
to mine the banks or bars of that
stream must first secure a licence
from the contiguous proprietor. If
there is no such proprietor then
such bars and banks are open to
location as any other mineral
ground.
