### Pension Money to Be Returned.

The late Isaac Lloyd, who, in a letter to his brother Malcolm, concerning the disposition of his estate said that he had always expected to return his unused pension to the government, excepting he should be in distress or want, was three years in the army during the Civil War, and wounded. His family, it is said, did not know that he had obtained a pension until the letter concerning the disposition of his estate was read.

The pension money was found intact, as he had stated, in his safe deposit box. It amounts to several thousand dollars, and will be paid back to the federal government, as he requested. Members of Mr. Lloyd's family says that he was a man of great probity, with particular sensitiveness to moral obligations in money affairs, and they consider his direction to return his pension money to the government an act of great patriotism.—The Ledger.
