It is reported that the Cubans have been stealing some of the guns that they had previously turned over to the United States for a consideration. They probably expect to present them again and get another \$75 apiece. These children of the tropics are getting onto Yankee tricks very rapidly.

The receipts of the Suez canal in 1898 were \$17,581,200. This was the largest business in its history, while the cost of maintaining the canal was about \$50,000 less than usual. The surplus of receipts over expenditures was \$9,757,800; and, as the directors have allotted to the reserve the sum of \$434,200 the net surplus is \$9,323,600.

Gen. Anderson, who led the first military detachment to the Philippines, says that the Filipinos are to be pitied more than blamed for inactivity and suspicious natures. They fought a hundred years or more for freedom, during which time "they were never told the truth and never knew justice." They came to look upon all foreigners as tyrants and oppressors.

There will be four notable elections for governor in November; in Maryland and Kentucky among the border states, and in Iowa and Ohio among the Western states. The other governorship contests will be practically uncontested, Massachusetts being overwhelmingly republican. Iowa, Ohio, Maryland and Kentucky have, all four, republican governors at present, though Kentucky is normally a democratic state and Maryland is usually so.

Last Saturday Governor Geer issued the annual proclamation, calling the attention of the public to the crimes and misdemeanors declared in the "act to protect timber and other property from fire," with the penalties prescribed, and warning all persons not to violate any of the provisions of the law.

FUNSTON'S AMBITION.

General Funston writes a letter to a friend in this city, dated May 13, as follows: "On general principles I am not an expansionist; but I believe that since we were, by an unfortunate train of circumstances, thrown into this thing, we should stay with it to the bitter end and rawhide these bullet-headed Asiatic ruffians until they yell for mercy. And after the war I want the job of professor of American history in Luzon university, when they build it—and I'll warrant that the new generation of Filipinos will know better than to get in the way of the bandwagon of Anglo-Saxon progress and decency."—Washington Post.
