A new coin 3 cent piece has been authorized by Act of Congress to take the place of the old coin which was so much like a dime that its coinage was stopped. The new 3 cent piece is ordered to be of nickel, the size of the old bronze cent, only thicker. In the center is to be a hole one-fourth of an inch in diameter. This will make the coin easily distinguishable by sight or touch. It will be some time however, before the new coin will be put in circulation.

The war revenue bill will be revised and taxes cut down materially during the next session of Congress.

This has been decided on by the House Ways and Means Committee and that committee will ask the House for authority to sit and examine witnesses upon that bill during the recess of Congress. At these sittings the entire revenue act will be gone over and a revised bill prepared for introduction on the first day of the next session.
