The total valuation of all the property in the state of Oregon for assessment and taxation purposes is less than \$77,000,000, or over \$2,000,000 less than last year.

It is estimated that more than \$1,000,000 has been sent to India from the United States for the help of the famine and plague sufferers. The New York committee, which disbanded lately, raised \$272,888.

The state bounty on coyote scalps for the protection of the sheep industry has caused the killing of many thousand coyotes on Eastern Oregon plains. And as a result, the farmers of that section are complaining that since they have been thinned out, squirrels, gophers and field mice have become numerous and destructive, and ask that the bounty law be repealed.

There are in the United States seventeen copper mines, capitalized for \$150,550,000, that have paid dividends amounting to \$177,727,398. In other words, they have paid to their stockholders \$19,176,398 more than the aggregate of the capital stock. These seventeen mines do not include several very large copper-producing properties owned by private companies, which do not make public their production of profits.

A copper nugget weighing fifteen pounds and eleven ounces was found on the beach of the Flambeau River, fifteen miles southwest of Tony, Wis., by Ed. K. Brown, of Eau Claire, who was on a land inspecting excursion. It was brought to Tony, and upon examination it

was found to be pure, containing no quartz or foreign substance whatever.

After 30 Years.

The Nicaragua canal project has been before Congress since 1869. The first Commission was appointed by President Grant in 1872. It reported on February 7, 1896, in favor of the Nicaragua route. The report of the last commission, just made, is almost a verbatim repetition, in essentials, of the first commission. There is no need of further delay. Public sentiment demands the canal; all parties have declared in favor of it; it has been repeatedly and officially declared by competent men to be feasible: Nicaragua and Costa Rica are favorable; a treaty can be made with England, or the canal can be constructed without a treaty; and so it is the duty of congress to bear down all opposition, from whatever quarter, and authorize without further delay the inauguration of this great work.—Telegram.

Bryan, it is understood has agreed to accept the place as the only way of preventing two Republicans from being elected. Thompson and Bryan will combine.

Under the United States bankruptcy law, which has now been in force about two years, 337 cases have come before Alexander Sweek, referee in bankruptcy for Multnomah County, less than 1 per cent of which have been involuntary. The provisions of the law have been taken advantage of chiefly by persons who had old debts hanging over them, from which they desired to obtain a discharge, rather than by merchants in financial embarrassment.

The battle for the Oregon senatorship to succeed McBride is taking form, and suites of rooms are already engaged at Hotel Willamette for at least three aspirants, and for twenty days on and after Friday, Jan. 11th. The legislature meets on Monday the 14th. Ex Senator Corbett will be here and take personal charge of his candidacy. He will make an open fight for the honor, and cast aside all the manipulating and secret methods of the past. McBride is expected to be here, as well as Mitchell and Fulton. Governor Geer says in the most emphatic manner that he will not allow his name to be sprung as a candidate under any circumstance. There is a growing impression that the fight will really lie between Corbett and Mitchell, and that it will be a battle royal. The speakership will be kept out if possible as well as the presidency of the senate.—Salem Journal.
