DOWER RIGHTS IN MINING CLAIMS.

Question:— Is it necessary for a grantor's
wife to sign a quit claim deed conveying
an unpatented mining claim?

Answer:— Under the law of Oregon,
cower cannot attach to an equity. The
interest in a mining claim, previous to
the payment of any money for the grant
of the patent on the land, is nothing
more than a right to the exclusive posses-
sion of the land, based upon conditions
subsequent, and a failure to perform such
conditions forfeits the locator's interest
in the claim; he has no such interest in
the property as will sustain a claim of
dower therein against his grantee under
a deed in which his wife did not join.

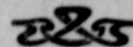
