250 Sheets, 16 or 32 ounces \$1.85

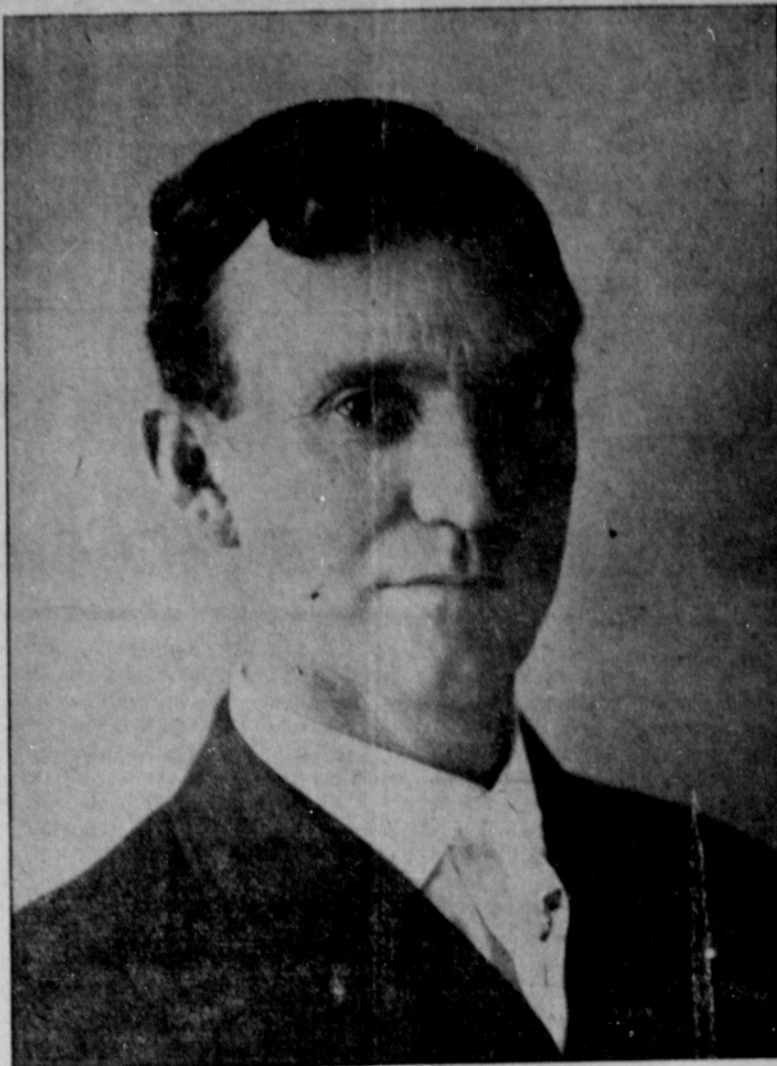

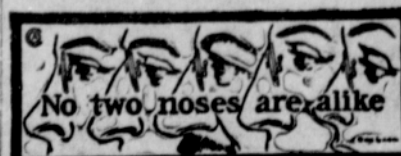
