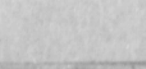

Why We Need a National Umpire

As happened after the crash of the Blue Eagle, the recent decision invalidating A. A. A. has accused various proposals for a change in our American form of government.

A typical suggestion is that we withdraw from the Supreme Court some or all of its authority to hold elected officials to the course mapped out for them in the Federal Constitution, and thereby extend to Congress the power to steer our ship of state among whatever shoals or channels may strike its fancy.

There is nothing either new or impossible about such proposals. They can be translated into reality by the mere adoption of any one of several amendments now pending in Washington. Let the American people agree to relinquish to Congress certain rights granted them by the Constitution and preserved by the Supreme Court—and the thing is accomplished.

That's what advocates of those amendments are asking us to do.

But, simple as this idea can be made to sound, it remains a serious and dangerous proposal. It strikes at the very root of accepted American principles in government. Before we consider any such course let's pause to remind ourselves of several facts of our past and current history. Let's recall, for example:

That alone, among the greater nations of earth, our country has retained its form of government unchanged during the past century.

That much of the permanence and success of its government has been attributed to the system of checks and balances between executive, judicial and legislative branches, and between the states and Washington. It is based on the principle that the right of the people and the states to govern themselves shall not be usurped by central authority.

That under our form of government America has enjoyed a larger share of happiness and prosperity than any other nation.

That none of the nations which in recent years have shifted to the newer forms now popular in Europe have achieved anything that can be envied by the American people.

And finally:
That whatever passing benefits various odd experiments may offer a favored few, they do not hold the solution of our problems. Despite the alluring phrases of economic crooners, America still subscribes to the essential truth and wisdom expressed by George Washington when he said:
"Nothing but harmony, honesty, industry and frugality are necessary to make us a great and happy people."

sending out such notices spring out periodically in various parts of the country, and almost invariably their existence is of brief duration, for the so-called service they offer is of negligible value the Bureau states. Briefly, these bureaus operate in this manner: they secure newspapers from numerous towns and cities, usually from points in other states, and clip all articles of any nature, in which a name and address appear. To these people they send a card similar to the one quoted.

Ordinarily, those responding to these cards are under the impression they will receive an article which appeared in a paper in the city in which the clipping bureau operates, but find, upon receipt of the clipping, that it is some minor mention in their home town paper and of little interest or value. Some of these so-called clipping bureaus clip any sort of notice, legal or otherwise, in which a name and address appear. Not infrequently these operations have been fraudulent in character, with the operators making little, if any, effort to send any type of clipping in exchange for the fee.

Oregon Had Motorists from Many States and Countries Last Year

Oregon entertained motorists from every state in the union last year, and then some. For they came also from India, the Dutch West Indies, Alaska, District of Columbia, Hawaii, Canada, Canal Zone, Panama, Philippines, Cuba, England, Mexico, and South America. The total number of automobiles registered was 100,303.

Of the total number, 53,450 were from California. Washington sent 17,564, Idaho 3521, Canada 2797, Nebraska 1748, Colorado 1644, Montana 1584, Illinois 1413, Kansas 1356, Minnesota 1065. There were 14 each from Delaware and Vermont and that was the lowest figure from any of the states.

EFFICIENT BRAKES

When brakes wear down to a point where there is any question about their efficiency they should be given immediate attention, according to W. R. McDonald, director of the Oregon State Motor association in charge of safety. When applied, brakes convert speed energy into heat energy, he pointed out. Heat causes expansion and as most brakes are of the internal type, with bands inside the drums, long and hard application causes the drum to expand away from the lining. If the brakes are only fair when drums are cold, they may fail entirely when hot.

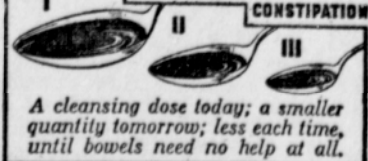

On Oregon Farms

Drills Well for Irrigation
ALBANY—The first deep well to be dug in Linn county for irrigation purposes will be that on the farm of E. R. Garner of route 3, Albany. Mr. Garner is drilling a 12-inch casing well from which he hopes to obtain at about 60 foot depth water enough to irrigate a large acreage of ladino clover and other crops, according to F. C. Mullen, county agent.

Local Corn Seed Proves Best
HILLSBORO — Local Minnesota "13" seed corn is superior to Idaho Minnesota "13" seed corn for the production of silage, because it produces an equal tonnage on a dry weight basis and in addition yields on an average of 1½ tons more ears per acre. This is the conclusion drawn from the results of silage corn trials carried on by five Washington county farmers last summer in cooperation with County Agent W. F. Cyrus. The Idaho seed produced about six tons per acre more silage than the local seed, but this increase was all water, as on a dry weight basis the local seed produced 134 pounds higher per acre, it was found.

Study Malting Requirements
DALLAS — Several Polk county farmers, accompanied by County Agent J. R. Beck, visited the Western Malting company plant at Vancouver, Washington, recently to make a first hand study of the methods of malting barley and the requirements of plants of this type. Their findings are for use at the Polk county farm outlook conference.

din potatoes for home use and for growing seed last year, are all enthusiastic over the results obtained, reports County Agent J. J. Inskeep. Mr. Inskeep believes that this potato, developed by the U. S. Department of Agriculture, has a number of advantages, especially for home use, as it is resistant to mosaic virus diseases, is an excellent cooking potato and the crop grades nearly all number ones.

CLEAR WINDSHIELD

Frost or snow on the windshield makes driving hazardous, but relief from this difficulty can be had by inserting a small block of wood under each side of the upper rear hood panel, according to the safety department of the Oregon State Motor association. This will allow the warm air from the motor to be blown against the windshield by the fan, thereby keeping the windshield clear.
