Fresh Water Game Fish Get Thorough Study

A thorough study of fresh water game fish problems in Oregon is being conducted by Dr. H. S. Davis of Washington, D C, who is is charge of Aquicultural Investiga tions for the U. S. Fish and Wile Life Service.

Dr. Davis, one of the world's most noted fish biologists and pathologists, is being assisted by Dr. P. R. Needham of Stanford University, who is in charge of similar work on the Pacific Coast.

The present study, according to Dr. Davis, will include fish hatcheries, artificial cultivation of fish, fish management and planting of fish, together with stream surveys.
