particular significance may be attached to sections of the pending bill with references to off street parking facilities and federal assistance in acquiring rights of way. While primarily intended to assure rapid progress in meeting urgent highway needs, these provisions are indicative of new Congressional thinking on highway development. In brief, the bending proposal on off street parking facilities provides that where states or political subdivisions ban parking on metropolitan connections of interstate highways, the Federal Government can give federal assistance for off street parking facilities for an equivalent number of vehicles. 
