THE SENATE TARIFF BILL.

The Senate tariff bill increases the tax on borax, used in soaps, for glass-making, and in many arts and manufactures, from four to five cents a pound, and from eighty per cent advalorem to one hundred per cent.

It increases the tax on glue from twenty-five to forty per cent. It increases the tax on orange mineral paint—a very common variety—from seventy to eighty per cent, while chrome yellows and greens, made in this country successfully since 1789, and without any duty, and long an article of export, have twenty-five per cent laid on them in the present tariff.

The duty on Portland cement is increased from twenty to thirty-two per cent; on vermilion red from twenty-five to seventy-five per cent; and on spirit varnishes from ninety-five to one hundred and four per cent.

The tax on tuggers' iron, used for buttons, is proposed to be raised from thirty to sixty-five per cent; and on the whole range of sheet iron and steel an increase of from five to thirty per cent is proposed.

In ordinary table cutlery the knives, forks and spoons used by the poorest people, and by the millions, now pay thirty-five per cent. The Senate bill increases the duty to fifty and sixty per cent.

HARRISON carried twenty States, by aggregate majorities of 476,000, and Cleveland has carried eighteen States by aggregate majorities of 556,000, giving Cleveland a popular majority of 80,000, or 18,000 more than he received in 1854.
