Probate Matters Transacted by Public Administrator.

Letters testamentary of the will of Robert McChellin, deceased, was filed in the probate court today. H. T. McChellin is named as administrator of the estate.

Harry Krebs, administrator of the estate of Mary J. Green, deceased, has filed his second report with the probate court. The administrator's report shows that the disbursements of the estate have exceeded the receipts by \$1,25, which amount he has personally advanced, and he petitions the court to make an order allowing him to dispose of personal property belonging to the estate sufficient to reimburse himself in accordance with his petition. JOHN DILLON'S VIEWS.

He Sends a Message to Banqueters at Kansas City.

John Dillon, Irish leader in the English parliament, was invited to send a message to be read at the recent banquet of the Marquette club in the city, which developed enthusiastic cheers. Mr. Dillon's reply, which was delayed in transit, has just been made public. It is dated Dublin, February 22, and says in part:

"In Ireland we regard the war now being waged by the British government against the two republics of South Africa as the most unjust, criminal and cowardly of the century."

"In order to deserve liberal opinion in Great Britain and abroad, a protest was put forward—that the object of the attacks on the republics was to secure equal rights for the outlanders. The majority of the protest has been exposed by the fact that outlanders of all races except English are fighting in the armies of the two republics. To use the words of Secretary Reitz, 'great magnates to the Free States,' according to the colonial secretary, England has constituted herself champion of the outlanders, and what do we find? On the borders side by side with the outlanders, we find those same outlanders hundreds, Germans, Irishmen, Frenchmen, Belgians and Scandinavians and even Englishmen, ready to lay down their lives in order to rid themselves of their self-constituted champion."

"All the civilized world now sees that the real object of this conspiracy and war against the republics of South Africa is to deprive the republics of their liberty, to steal their gold mines, to increase dividends by reducing the wages of laborers in Johannesburg and to establish the ascendancy of the English race over all other races in South Africa."
