It is not only a triumph for the United States and the American state department, but it is a victory for peace and good fellowship and free relations between the nations. The United States, the only power which has no pretense to a "sphere of influence" in China, has interposed its voice and secured from those who have or who aspire to such territorial control pledges of fair dealing to all the world and respect for China's sovereign rights.

SOUTH AFRICA AND INDIA.

The New York World points a moral by giving a lesson in the pretense of "glory" and the "moral mission" of Empire. The theory of empire is that its murder, robbery and tyranny are merely incidental, that the real objects, the real ideals which imperialists ever cherish and ever bear in mind, are the material and moral progress of both conquerors and conquered.

How does England at the present moment fill the theory? She is spending upward of \$1,500,000 a day—\$45,000,000 a month—in conquering the South African republics because the Transvaal refused to turn its government over to her under a pretended scheme of "reform." At the same time a famine is raging among her wards in India and tens of thousands of her "wards" are dying of hunger, and she can afford only an abnormally inadequate provision for relief.

And according to a carefully compiled report of a British parliamentary commission, controlled by the government, English rule in India during the past twenty years has resulted in conditions of land ownership which have lessened the power of resistance to famine of the great mass of England's wards. The report says of this vast population:

"It is a sensitive or liability to succumb to famine, instead of diminishing, is possibly becoming more accentuated; and of the area subject to famine, far from contracting, it is actually widening."

What would be thought of a father who left his children to starve while he went out to hire a band of braves and attack his peaceful neighbor because his neighbor was unwilling to be robbed?
