GEER'S ACTION TIMELY.

It May Bring Good Results on Reservation in Eradicating Mangle.

Deputy State Veterinarian Thomas Thompson, whose jurisdiction is Umatilla county, was shown the letter sent by Governor Geer to the Oregon congressional delegation on the subject of mangle among range horses, and stated that the governor's action in the premises was very timely, and would probably be the means of solving the perplexing problem which has puzzled the horsemen of this section of country.

Governor Geer, at the instance of Mr. Thompson, who recently met him in Portland, addressed a letter to the Senators and Representatives from this state in Washington, saying that the mangle disease was present on the Umatilla Indian reservation in this county, that it was spreading, that it was causing the infection of the horses owned by the white people, and that it had been impossible for the state authorities to do anything toward eradicating it. The difficulty under which the state officials have labored is that the Indian agent denies the authority of the state veterinarian and his deputies to go upon the reservation and kill the infected animals. The position taken by the agent is supported by the federal officials at Washington, and thus arises the conflict between the state and federal government, pending the settlement of which, large numbers of many animals roam the range, and no man's horse is safe from catching the disease.

Mr. Thompson has been the deputy at this point for several years, and two years ago caused more than a thousand comparatively worthless range horses to be killed. "In all the territory of this county, outside the reservation," says Mr. Thompson, "the disease was almost completely eliminated. The killing of so many infected horses, left but comparatively few who were diseased, and these were, in many instances, horses of sufficient value to warrant curative methods. The refusal of the federal authorities to allow the state to go upon the reservation has left the disease there practically unchecked. In lieu of the action of the state officials, absolutely nothing has been done by the Indian agent, nor the federal government."

Mr. Thompson claims that the Indian agent has full authority to cause the killing of these infected animals, as the state has the authority to kill them in other parts of the county, but that the agent has refused to do anything, owing probably to an indisposition on his part to arouse the antagonism of the Indians. Almost none of the Indian ponies diseased on the reservation have been killed, and the situation is regarded by horsemen as quite critical, and inimical to the interests of a great industry of this section.

It is the proposition of the governor that the secretary of the interior take steps to come to some understanding with the state officials and that one or the other of them take the task in hand, and vigorously pursue it. It is hoped here very earnestly that the matter will not be pigeon-holed at Washington, but that the courteous letter of Governor Geer, and the valid arguments therein presented, will call for some definite action by the interior department.

The horse industry of this county is rapidly becoming one of vast proportions. Not only are very many fine work horses raised now, from finely-bred stallions, but also the introduction of some of the famous racing stallions into this section and the raising of blooded mares has produced a race of remarkably fine racing and road animals. It is thought that the government owes it to the horsemen to protect them by the enforcement of the laws now upon the statute book, which, if enforced, will prevent the spread of that disease, which is now alarmingly on the increase.

ATHLETIC EVENTS. Field Day Sports Planned for the Next Several Weeks.

A number of Pendleton young men have formed an association which it is proposed to make of an athletic nature, and on Tuesday evening, tomorrow, they will give a dance at the Armory hall to raise some funds for necessary expenses. The chief event towards which they are looking is a field day in which they will participate. The giving of a dancing party is in lieu of asking contributions from people on the subscription plan, and no one will be solicited to pay any money, except by purchasing tickets and attending the dance.

They hope to secure co-operation from Walla Walla, Baker City and other towns in the field day, which is to be on about June 3.

The dance is in charge of a committee appointed for that purpose—Mort Meach, Charles Cameron and Sol Baum. Kirkman's orchestra has been secured for the occasion.

Members of the football and baseball teams are in the association and several of them are capable of establishing some good records.

The field day of the Pendleton public schools and the Weston normal school has been arranged for Saturday, May 19. Principal E. B. Conklin and President D. V. Reid, of the two institutions, have arranged the date and the preliminaries. The contests will be had on the Peringer & Simpson race track east from town, where the program will be carried out, it is hoped, before a large assemblage of people. The events are being planned, and the young athletes are training for the contests.

FOR THE HORSE PARADE. Portland Horsemen Will Be Here Next Saturday to See It.

Cris Simpson has returned from Portland, where he went last week. While in Portland, Mr. Simpson found the horsemen of that place are much interested in the horse parade to be had here on Saturday next, and about a dozen will be here on that day. Mr. Simpson was interviewed while in Portland by a representative of the Evening Telegram, which said:

Pendleton may be said to be the headquarters in Oregon for blooded horses," remarked Cris Simpson, of that place, who owns some good racing stock himself and has a large farm near there. He will attend the July races in Everett and later book his horses for the Irvington track races.

Among good stock owned by Mr. Simpson is Alta Norte, 2:10 1/2; Doc

Wright, a green pacer and a colt by McKinney, out of the dam Bonner, N. B., 2:17. Other owners of good horses mentioned by Mr. Simpson, is Frank Frazier, who owns Umatilla, 2:12 1/2, the daughter of Chehalis; George Perringer, who owns Pathmark 2:08 1/2, a 2-year-old pacer, and a full sister of Umatilla, Robert Starkweather.

Pendleton is such a fine horse center, Mr. Simpson says, because the climate is conducive to training and breeding. In time he believes that place will gain a worldwide reputation for breeding racers and thoroughbreds.

In speaking of the crop prospects, Mr. Simpson said: "The grain never looked better and the yield promises to be something enormous. Mr. Perringer expects to raise 100,000 bushels. This is my off year, and I do not expect to raise more than 28,000 bushels. But the average promises to be greater than any previous year. There may be other good sections of country, but you never see a Umatilla man who cares to pull up stakes."
