Sheep Grazing.
Washington, May 3.—Mr. Gifford Pinchot, forester of the department of agriculture, and Mr. F. C. Colville, biologist of the same department, will leave Washington for the west about May 5, to make a personal investigation of the problem of grazing in the forest reserves. The restriction of sheep grazing in these areas has raised a strong protest from woolgrowers, and public feeling in the west has become divided and intense. A plan for an exhaustive investigation, by the government, was published a few weeks ago; but this time of this official will be the first actual work in the field.
