The European powers are told by Secretary Hay that it is "the purpose of the president to act concurrently with the other powers." In truth, in aiding to prevent a spread of the disorder to other provinces and recurrence of such disasters. The spirit of empire is apparent even here. "The purpose of the president." That great imperial high-mightiness the president will co-operate with "the other powers" not merely in protecting American life and property, not merely in doing what the American people, hitherto supposed to bear the relation to the president of sovereign to servant, may have authorized, but in using American armaments and soldiers in "aiding to prevent a recurrence of such disasters." That is, Mr. McKinley will use the armies and navies of the United States arbitrarily and without authority in pacifying China.

MAN'S FOUR ENEMIES. There are four enemies that have stood in the path of a man, says David Starr Jordan. These are aristocracy, militarism, slavery and imperialism. There are various other enemies, but these are the four arch enemies in the political sense. They all spring out of the idea that man belongs not to himself, but to somebody or something else which owns him. These four enemies are a dangerous garb confront the United States today.

Schiller says that the tyrants reach hands to each other—that they reach to each other's hands. They stand together now. These four stand together. Wherever there is one of the other is. Aristocracy, slavery, militarism and imperialism. They reach each other's hand.

They all have their fair, attractive side. They are defended sometimes at the bedside. Slavery was discussed and defended from many a pulpit in New England. Aristocracy has its fair side.

The foundation of quality is aristocracy. The foundation of our own liberty is rebellion against it—the very thing we came here for.

There is a fair side of slavery and a fair side of militarism. How clean the streets can be kept under military discipline and how free from noise! How easily people can be sent to bed at dark if it be desired!

There is a fair side of imperialism. You will find that in many places nine-tenths of the people believe it is a good thing for the world. Maybe it is, but when we come to read history from the one side to the other we will find that the British people have been deluged by their course in India and that the Hindus have been cursed.

We know how Napoleon depopulated France by his war. We know of the murders of the nobility, the uprisings of the peasantry and the result in the France of today. In 1830, when the Philippine question was a burning one

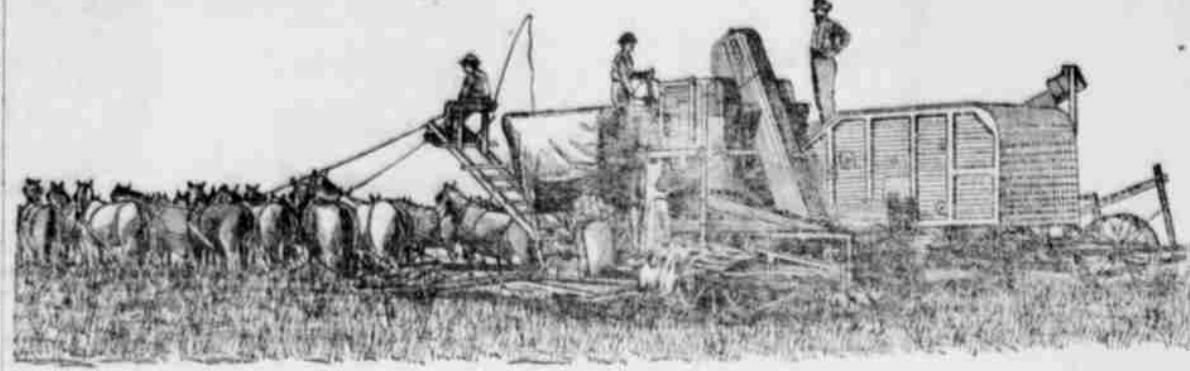
