Furthermore, not a remote possibility is the long contemplated plan for building a cut-off from Echo to about Castle Rock and thus causing the mainline to avoid the present station of Umatilla.

This morning, Contractors Hale and Aldrich alighted from the train with blue prints of plans for the improvement. They have come with the apparent intention of looking over the ground, and bidding for the contract to do the work proposed.

The track between Pendleton and Umatilla has a number of curves, and there are several hills necessitating rather heavy grades. The difference between the hauling of trains down from Pendleton to Umatilla and in hauling them up from Umatilla to Pendleton is considerable enough to compel adding several minutes to the running time going up.

The plans, so it has for a long time been understood, contemplate making a cut-off, so the main line would run from Echo across the flat country to strike the line again at about Castle Rock, on the Columbia river.

Whether the company intends now to begin this work cannot be said, excepting by the company itself, and, of course, no one connected with the corporation in a capacity to speak officially will tell. All is therefore guesswork, at this time.
